WHAT HAPPENED TODAY

White House Chief of Staff Mark Meadows criticized Speaker Nancy Pelosi (D-CA) over the inability to come to an agreement on further COVID-related aid. Meadows indicated **he is not optimistic** the parties will be able to reach a deal before September, as the Trump Administration has not "seen a lot of action" from Democratic leaders.

Additionally, Meadows announced the White House is considering further executive actions in lieu of coronavirus relief legislation. Referencing the recent airline layoffs, Meadows **stated** the Administration hopes to "help out the airlines and keep some of those employees from being furloughed."

- The IRS **will soon send** Economic Impact Payment (EIP) checks to individuals whose portion of the EIP was diverted to pay their spouse's past-due child support.
