



DAILY COVID-19 UPDATE

September 29, 2020

WHAT HAPPENED TODAY

Yesterday, Speaker Pelosi unveiled a revised \$2.2 trillion coronavirus relief package, about \$1.2 trillion less than the *HEROES Act*. The scaled back bill includes, among other things, funding for COVID-19 testing, contact tracing, and isolation measures; procurement, distribution, and education campaigns for a coronavirus vaccine; a second round of stimulus checks; boosted unemployment benefits through January; assistance for states and housing; and aid for airlines, restaurants, and small businesses. Notably, in their newly released plan, Democrats reduced funding for states to \$436 billion, down from their previous demand for \$915 billion.

Speaker Pelosi and Secretary Mnuchin met for nearly an hour this morning to discuss the new House proposal. The pair have agreed to meet again tomorrow to continue negotiations.

LATEST STATISTICS

There are a total of 33,477,825 confirmed cases worldwide, 1,003,922 deaths and 23,209,109 people have recovered.

There are 7,176,111 confirmed cases of the coronavirus in the U.S., 205,676 deaths and 2,794,608 people have recovered.

The coronavirus has killed more than 1 million people worldwide. The U.S. accounts for more than 20% of COVID deaths.

President Trump previously indicated he is open to supporting a maximum of \$1.5 trillion in aid. Speaker Pelosi stated the White House will have to agree to "much more" spending if there is any hope of reaching an agreement on another stimulus bill prior to the election.

Additionally, President Trump **announced** yesterday that the federal government will begin distributing 100 million Abbott rapid point-of-care COVID-19 tests to states and territories this week. Governors are encouraged to utilize the tests to reopen K-12 schools for in-person learning and supporting critical infrastructure and first responders, among other things.
