WHAT HAPPENED TODAY

Over the weekend, Secretary Mnuchin and White House Chief of Staff Mark Meadows [sent a letter](#) to Congress urging lawmakers to pass a targeted small business aid bill, as broader stimulus negotiations continue. Secretary Mnuchin and Meadows stated the Senate and House must pass a bill to allow federal agencies to spend the unused Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) funds "while we continue to work toward a comprehensive package."

Today, Speaker Nancy Pelosi (D-CA) [called](#) the Trump Administration's latest proposal "one step forward, two steps back." Speaker Pelosi cited "inadequacies" with funding for state and local governments, COVID-19 testing, working families, rental assistance, small businesses, elections, and the census. However, she stated she remains "hopeful" a comprehensive aid package can be negotiated.

Additionally, Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell (R-KY) [announced](#) the Senate will vote on a targeted coronavirus relief bill when the chamber returns next week. Leader McConnell stated the "first order of business" upon return will be to vote on "targeted relief for American workers," which includes new funding for the PPP. The targeted legislation [will also include](#) more money for unemployment insurance, schools, and hospitals.

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

- HHS and the Department of Defense (DoD) announced an [**agreement**](#) with AstraZeneca for late-stage development and large-scale manufacturing of the company's COVID-19 investigational product AZD7442, a cocktail of two monoclonal antibodies.
- On behalf of HHS, DOD awarded an [**Other Transaction Agreement**](#) to Cue Health Inc. of San Diego, California to expand U.S. production capacity of point-of-care COVID-19 tests.

NATIONAL INSTITUTES OF HEALTH

- The National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) launched the [**ACTIV-5 Big Effect Trial**](#), a study to determine whether certain approved therapies or investigational drugs in late-stage clinical development show promise against COVID-19 and merit advancement into larger clinical trials.
