WHAT HAPPENED TODAY

Today, President Trump **called** for a larger stimulus package than the White House's most recent offer of \$1.8 trillion. During an interview on Fox Business, President Trump stated he "would take more" and "go higher," echoing his previous comments this week of "go big or go home."

Additionally, Secretary Mnuchin **signaled** today his willingness to accept Speaker Pelosi's national COVID-19 testing strategy. Secretary Mnuchin stated he is ready to "fundamentally agree with their testing language." However, Speaker Pelosi's spokesperson stated the Speaker has not been informed of any specifics on what Secretary Mnuchin is willing to agree on.

Even though President Trump and his Administration are willing to accept a larger stimulus package, Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell (R-

KY) **asserted** Senate Republicans will not vote for a larger package. Leader McConnell told reporters in Kentucky "a half a trillion dollars, highly targeted, is the best way to go." Additionally, he **added** he would not put a larger package negotiated by Speaker Pelosi and Secretary Mnuchin on the floor.
