November 9, 2020

WHAT HAPPENED TODAY

Today, President-Elect Joe Biden unveiled his 13-member **COVID-19 Transition Advisory Board**, composed of doctors and public health experts including former Surgeon General Dr. Vivek Murthy, former BARDA Director Dr. Rick Bright, and high-profile surgeon and public health researcher Dr. Atul Gawande, among others.

The group will develop a plan to bring the coronavirus pandemic under control by managing surges in infections, ensuring vaccines are safe and effective, and vulnerable populations are protected. Biden has indicated that the plan will go into effect immediately following his inauguration on January 20, 2021.

Biden's coronavirus **plan's priorities** include: access to COVID-19 testing; ensuring access to Personal Protective Equipment (PPE); vaccine distribution strategy; additional funding for state and local governments, schools, and small business; and a national mask mandate, among others.

There are a total of **50,766,136** confirmed cases worldwide, 1,260,956 deaths and 33,139,539 people have recovered.

There are **10,042,654** confirmed cases of the coronavirus in the U.S., 237,835 deaths and 3,881,558 people have recovered.

Congress SENATE

- Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer (D-NY), along with Senators Mark Warner (D-VA), Sherrod Brown (D-OH), and Elizabeth Warren (D-MA), [sent a letter](#) to Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell and Treasury Secretary Steven Mnuchin urging them to expand emergency lending programs for businesses and states.

PUBLIC HEALTH UPDATE

Administration

NATIONAL INSTITUTES OF HEALTH

- An NIH clinical trial evaluating the safety and effectiveness of hydroxychloroquine for the treatment of adults with coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) has formally [concluded](#) that the drug provides no clinical benefit to hospitalized patients.

FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION

- FDA authorized the [first serology test](#) that detects neutralizing antibodies from recent or prior SARS-CoV-2 infection, which are antibodies that bind to a specific part of a pathogen and have been observed in a laboratory setting to decrease SARS-CoV-2 viral infection of cells. The FDA issued an emergency use authorization (EUA) for the cPass SARS-CoV-2 Neutralization Antibody Detection Kit, which specifically detects this type of antibody.
- FDA Commissioner Dr. Stephen Hahn issued a [statement](#) about the agency's guidance to enhance diversity in clinical trials and encourage inclusivity in medical product development.

DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

- DOL's Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has [issued guidance](#) and an accompanying [one-pager](#) to help employers understand which standards are most frequently cited during coronavirus-related inspections.
- Since the start of the coronavirus pandemic through Oct. 29, 2020, the DOL's Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has

issued [citations](#) arising from 179 inspections for violations relating to coronavirus, resulting in proposed penalties totaling \$2,496,768.
