DAILY COVID-19 UPDATE

December 7, 2020

WHAT HAPPENED TODAY

Today, the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) announced it will be awarding \$523 million in performance-based stimulus payments to over 9,000 nursing homes that achieved specific COVID-19 infection and death reduction benchmarks between September and October. Payments will be disbursed beginning December 9.

Additionally, a group of House and Senate lawmakers is expected to formally release, as soon as today, the legislative text of their bipartisan, bicameral \$908 billion coronavirus relief package. Senate Minority Whip Dick Durbin (D-IL), a member of the bipartisan group, stated he is unsure if Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell (R-KY) will agree to take up the bill on the floor. However, Senator Durbin stated Leader McConnell has expressed "some interest" and "positive feeling" towards the proposal.

Notably, to avoid a partial government shutdown on Friday, congressional leaders are expected to introduce a stopgap funding measure that would set December 18 as a new deadline for a final spending
