DAILY COVID-19 UPDATE

February 22, 2021

WHAT HAPPENED TODAY

Today, the House Budget Committee is marking up President Biden's \$1.9 trillion coronavirus relief package, teeing up a potential vote on the House floor on Friday or Saturday. Senate action could follow as soon as next week. In addition to any Senate amendments to the bill, the Senate parliamentarian must issue a determination related to provisions that are allowable or prohibited in the budget reconciliation bill. For example, there has been a lot of commentary that raising the minimum wage to \$15 an hour would violate budget reconciliation rules.

Additionally, President Joe Biden announced a series of reforms to further target the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) to the "smallest businesses and those that have been left behind in previous relief efforts." Specifically, the Administration announced it will institute a 14-day period during which only businesses with fewer than 20 employees can access the program. The Administration also revised the loan calculation formula to expand eligibility to sole proprietors, independent contractors, and the self-employed, among other reforms.
