



DAILY COVID-19 UPDATE

April 12, 2021

WHAT HAPPENED TODAY

Today, the World Health Organization (WHO) announced that the COVID-19 pandemic is now "growing exponentially" at more than 4.4 million cases per week -- eight times higher than this time last year. WHO noted that the world is "in a critical point of the pandemic," and urged countries to continue promoting the use of evidence-based control measures such as wearing masks, social distancing, avoiding gatherings, and washing hands. Additionally, WHO officials indicated that the virus is "stronger, faster," and more deadly with the emergence of new variants.

Yesterday, Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell discussed previous COVID-19 relief packages and the future economic outlook on 60 Minutes. Chair Powell stated the economic fallout from the COVID-19 pandemic "would've been so much worse" without the multiple stimulus packages. Specifically, he stated the CARES Act allowed people to remain in their homes and "replaced people's incomes" for those that experienced COVID-related layoffs. Additionally, Chair Powell projected "very strong" economic growth in the second half of the year but warned that

Congressional

HOUSE

- Reps. Darrell Issa (R-CA), Mike Levin (D-CA), Ken Calvert (R-CA), and Lou Correa (D-CA) introduced the Better Way for Providers to Repay Act. The [legislation](#) would delay the Medicare Advanced and Accelerated Payment (AAP) loan program repayment start date by three months to assist Medicare providers during COVID-19 recovery.
- Rep. Andy Biggs (R-AZ) introduced the [No Vaccine Passports Act](#), which would prevent federal agencies from issuing any standardized documentation that could be used to certify a U.S. citizen's COVID-19 status to a third party, such as a restaurant or an airline. Additionally, this [legislation](#) would prohibit proof of COVID-19 vaccination from being a requirement for access to federal or congressional property and services.
