DAILY COVID-19 UPDATE

April 23, 2021

Since Congress and the White House have shifted focus to a broader set of policy issues, we will be pausing distribution of the Daily COVID-19 Update starting today. However, we will continue to include COVID related health and economic updates in our Daily Dose and the Financial Services Week Ahead.

WHAT HAPPENED TODAY

Today, the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) reconvened to continue discussions regarding the safety of Johnson & Johnson's COVID-19 vaccine and review new data. The independent vaccine advisory board is expected to issue a recommendation to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) about how, or whether, the vaccine should be utilized going forward.

Top federal health officials indicated in [interviews](#) this week that Johnson & Johnson could resume distribution of their COVID-19 vaccine, as soon as this weekend, with a warning label about the rare blood clots. This action would mirror that of European regulators who concluded that the vaccine's benefits outweigh the risks.

LATEST STATISTICS

282,183,915 COVID-19 vaccines have been distributed in the U.S and **135,791,031** Americans have received the first dose.

There are a total of **144,948,730** confirmed cases worldwide, **3,076,076** deaths and **83,331,131** people have recovered.

There are **31,939,830** confirmed cases of the coronavirus in the U.S. and **570,463** deaths.

LATEST PMJ RESOURCES

According to an analysis by the Kaiser Family Foundation, within the next two to four weeks, the U.S. will reach a point where its COVID-19 vaccination **supply will exceed demand**. In order to achieve herd immunity and stop the spread of the virus, states will need to utilize new tactics to inoculate vaccine hesitant and indifferent individuals.
